Dear Friends,

The 14th of July this year will see a historic occasion happening in Hawkshead Church. Emily and Chris have come to the end of their first year as curates serving in the benefice, and they will be ordained as priests in a service at 5pm. This will be a very big day for them. Historically this has happened in the cathedral, but in recent years it has tended to happen in the parish in which the curates are serving. So, although I can't say for certain, I think it is quite likely that this is the first time an ordination service has happened in Hawkshead. Years ago, when I was ordained priest in Carlisle Cathedral, as it happens, I was the only person being ordained. When asked about this on Radio Cumbria, the Dean of the Cathedral, much to the delight of people I knew, said 'I'm afraid vou've caught us on a very bad year'. Well, this year, we've been caught on a very good year, as the Church will be gaining too very able and gifted priests to serve for years to come. As priests they are enabled to do most things the church might ask of them: preside at a communion service, bless people, conduct weddings and baptisms and so on. It is a privilege for us to be part of that in this place. And there is more good news as well, Chris and Emily will continue to be with us for a couple more years as they complete their curacies and bring us many blessings.
